Alistair reid "ally" macleod (26 february 1931 – 1 february 2004) was a scottish professional football player and manager. he is perhaps best known for his time as the scotland national football team manager, including their appearance at the 1978 fifa world cup

leod played as a left winger for third lanark (two spells), st mirren, blackburn rovers, hibernian and ayr united.

Walter ferguson smith obe (born 24 february 1948) is a scottish former football player, manager and director. he is primarily associated with his two spells as manager of scottish club rangers.. a former defender, smith's playing career consisted of two spells with dundee united, split by a short time at dumbarton.

a pelvic injury meant he moved into coaching at dundee united, working for Jack aitchison proved the difference during scotland under-19s 2-0 victory over the netherlands this afternoon... with some celtic fans now keen to see the youngster get some senior minutes before the end of the season. aitchison came through celtic's youth ranks and became the youngest player
