**Anatomy and physiology**

- anatomy deals with the structure (morphology) of the body and its parts; in other words, what are things called?
- physiology studies the functions of these parts or asks the question, "how do they work?"
- the two disciplines are closely interrelated because the functional role of a part depends on its structure.

**The circulatory system.**

(a) the circulatory system consists of a series of vessels that transport blood to and from the heart, the heart pump.

(b) the circulatory system has two major circuits: the pulmonary circuit, which transports blood to and from the lungs, and the systemic circuit, which transports blood to and from the body (excluding the heart).
