The term "continental philosophy", in the above sense, was first widely used by english-speaking philosophers to describe university courses in the 1970s, emerging as a collective name for the philosophies then widespread in france and germany, such as phenomenology, existentialism, structuralism, and post-structuralism. Continental philosophy, as the phrase is used today, refers to a set of traditions of nineteenth and twentieth century philosophy from mainland europe. continental philosophy includes the following movements: german idealism, phenomenology, existentialism (and its antecedents, such as the thoughts of kierkegaard and nietzsche), hermeneutics, structuralism, post-structuralism, french feminism

Robert c. solomon (september 14, 1942 – january 2, 2007) was an american professor of philosophy at the university of texas at austin, where he taught for more than 30 years. professor solomon won many teaching honors, including the standard oil outstanding teaching award in 1973; the university of texas president's associates teaching award (twice); a fulbright lecture award; university Bioethics. bioethics is a rather young academic inter-disciplinary field that has emerged rapidly as a particular moral enterprise against the background of the revival of applied ethics in the second half of the twentieth century.

Introduction. philosophy of education is the philosophical study of education, often understood as a field of applied philosophy that draws from established branches of philosophy in epistemology, ethics, axiology, and politics to raise and address questions of educational aims, methods, and problems, and of educational policy, pedagogy, and curriculum. Understood broadly, the debate between naturalists and nonnaturalists in ethics concerns the question of how morality, and in particular moral value, is related to the natural world. in contemporary philosophy, this is usually seen as primarily a metaphysical issue, though in the past the term Ethics, also called moral philosophy, the discipline concerned with what is morally good and bad, right and wrong. the term is also applied to any system or theory of moral values or principles.. how should we live? shall we aim at happiness or at knowledge, virtue, or the creation of beautiful objects? if we choose happiness, will it be our own or the happiness of all?
