A frame of snooker comprises the period of play from the first stroke, with all the balls set as described in section 3, rule 2, until the frame is completed by: (a) concession by any player during his turn A stroke is made when the striker strikes the cue-ball with the tip . of the cue. (b) a stroke is fair when no infringement of rule is made. (c) a stroke is not completed until all balls have come to rest. Rules of play (snooker) 1. a legally potted ball entitles the striker to continue at the table until he fails to legally pot a ball. 2. on all shots, the striker must comply with the appropriate requirements of rules of play 5 and 6.
