The heart muscle) is narrowed by a buildup of fatty deposits called plaque, it can reduce blood flow. If blood flow is reduced to the heart muscle, chest pain can result. If a clot forms and completely blocks the blood flow to part of the heart muscle, a heart attack results. Stents help keep coronary arteries open. Heart failure is one of the most common causes of heart-related illness and death in the U.S. How does heart failure occur? Heart failure may result from one or more of the following: coronary artery disease (blockage in the coronary arteries) an infection that may affect your heart, heart attack, high blood pressure. Heart attacks are caused by a blockage that stops blood flow to the heart. Heart attack refers to death of heart muscle tissue due to the loss of blood supply, not necessarily resulting in the death of the victim.
