Walk 13 - delph circular by joan senior os sheet: explorer o11: the peak district - dark peak & explorer o121: south pennines. both sheets required description: this walk includes a variety of terrains. it starts in the village of delph. it takes you via moors and reservoirs, then towards the village of diggle, Trail guide: trail key: difficulty rating for walks: walking car bus scenic historic time cycling easy moderate strenuous 2 hr this trail is one of 44 exciting trails to explore in the peak district & derbyshire. the 'fancy that' factor see a 1697 bath house and a 1300's bridge still carrying modern traffic find out why the pudding wars Peak district walk - 2½ miles round trip ilam park to dovedale stepping stones ilam park is a beautiful open space at the south end of the manifold valley. it was designed in the 19th century as an idyllic setting for ilam hall and is home to many dramatic mature trees. the manifold and hamps rivers re-emerge here after South & western lakeland, british mountain maps lake district (1:40 000) 1. from drigg station turn right and follow shore road south then west around the perimeter of the wooded plantation to a gate by the road head car park. watch out for the barn owl, this woodland is part of its territory! deer and red squirrels can sometimes be seen too. 2. Peak district national park authority, baslow road, bakewell, derbyshire de45 1ae south of buxton. at parsley hay it is joined from the south by the tissington trail, which runs for 13 miles use circular walks leaflets available at middleton top and high peak junction workshops information centres. The south end of the village, with a train station nearby. from the car park, follow a leafy lane towards the village centre, passing the rambler inn, national park visitor centre and parish church. a walnut tree at the village centre is the traditional starting point for the pennine way (1 = sk 123 860). Day walks in mackenzie/waitaki the mackenzie basin is the largest inter-montane (between mountains) basin in new zealand and is part of the south island 'high country'. the basin is ringed with rolling, tussock-clad mountains and on a fine day the views are spectacular. mackenzie basin rivers all drain into the waitaki river and out to the South of stocksbridge. os map outdoor leisure 1 – peak district, dark peak. access park at the western end of the private road which runs along the north side of more hall, near ewden village (point 1). difficulty 6 more hall barnsley sheffield rotherham doncaster photograph: roger nunn to discover walks, cycle rides, easy access paths Pedal the peakdistrict explore the best of the peak district on two wheels 9 journeys of discovery by bike explore the spectacular countryside of the peak district by bicycle on quiet lanes and traffic-free trails. Contrast, the white peak in the south is a lower, 'friendlier' and less-imposing landscape of pale limestone and fertile farmland, with tranquil grassy dales and wooded valleys running between the pasture-covered hills.
